1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

A meeting of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners (BOFPC) of the Village of La Grange was held on Tuesday, July 15, 2014 in the lower level conference room at the Village Hall and was called to order by Chairman Lies at 7:00 p.m.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

3. BUSINESS AT HAND

Welcome Acting Fire Chief Don Gay

Acting Fire Chief Don Gay was introduced to the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners. Don was appointed Acting Fire Chief as of Chief Bryzgalski's retirement on July 11.

Final Patrol Officer Eligibility Register A.1.

The Final Patrol Officer Eligibility Register and the Final Certified Patrol Officer Eligibility Register were submitted to the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners for approval.

It was noted that several candidates on both the registers have a tie score. According to the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners Chapter III - Examinations Police Original Appointments - Section 5 Final Eligibility Register (a) In the event of a tie score, the placement of the tied applicants' names on the Final Eligibility Register shall be determined by lot, in the presence of a quorum of the Board, in whatever manner the Board deems appropriate. The applicant's names were placed in a container and Commissioner Hoffenberg drew to break the ties as follows:

B. <u>Fire Department Update - Hiring process for Firefighter/Paramedic</u>

Acting Fire Chief Don Gay notified the Commissioners that the firefighter/paramedic candidates are being scheduled for their pre-employment tests which include polygraph test, psychological exam and medical physical.

Acting Fire Chief Don Gay informed the Commissioners that the Promotional Fire Lieutenants Register will expire in December 2014 and that with the BOFPC's consent, he intends to utilize the same testing process as has been done in the past.

At Chairman Lies' request Don gave an overview of his fire service career.

Police Chief Holub informed the Commissioners that the Police Sergeant promotional testing process has been completed and that he would forward the score components to Recording Secretary Cathy Benjamin to develop the initial promotional register to be forwarded onto the candidates for application of military points.
