1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

A meeting of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners (BOFPC) of the Village of La Grange was held on Monday, June 6, 2016 in the lower level conference room at the Village Hall and was called to order at 6:02 p.m.

PRESENT: (and constituting a quorum): Commissioner Hoffenberg and Commissioner Kerpan.

ALSO PRESENT: Renee Strasser, Police Chief and Don Gay, Fire Chief.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Commissioner Hoffenberg to approve the minutes of the June 2, 2016 meeting, seconded by Commissioner Kerpan. Motion carried.

3. BUSINESS AT HAND

A. Conditional Offer of Employment – Police Department – Candice Nevins-Cassiberry

Chief Strasser reported that a background investigation had been performed on Candice Nevins-Cassiberry and as a result of the findings of the investigation, she recommended that a conditional job offer be made and that she be authorized to proceed with the other steps necessary to qualify her as a candidate for employment.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hoffenberg and seconded by Commissioner Kerpan to offer Candice Nevins-Cassiberry a conditional offer of employment. Motion carried.

B. Conditional Offer of Employment – Police Department – Michael Kaiser

Chief Strasser reported that a background investigation had been performed on Michael Kaiser and as a result of the findings of the investigation, she recommended that a conditional job offer be made and that she be authorized to proceed with the other steps necessary to qualify him as a candidate for employment.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hoffenberg and seconded by Commissioner Kerpan to offer Michael Kaiser a conditional offer of employment. Motion carried.

C. Completion of Probationary Requirement – Police Department – Bret Hon

Chief Strasser reported that Officer Bret Hon had successfully completed his probationary period on March 23, 2016. She recommended that the Commission remove him from probationary status.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hoffenberg and seconded by Commissioner Kerpan to remove Officer Bret Hon from probationary status. Motion carried.

D. Completion of Probationary Requirement – Police Department – Jin Kang

Chief Strasser reported that Officer Jin Kang had successfully completed his probationary period on March 18, 2016. She recommended that the Commission remove him from probationary status.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hoffenberg and seconded by Commissioner Kerpan to remove Officer Jin Kang from probationary status. Motion carried.

4. OLD BUSINESS

Chief Strasser reported that Taylor Falls is doing well in Field Training and is scheduled to complete it in July.

5. NEW BUSINESS

Chief Strasser reported that Kyle Niewold will graduate on June 24th from the Police Academy and begin his 3 month field training program thereafter.
