1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

A meeting of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners (BOFPC) of the Village of La Grange was held on Thursday, June 23, 2016 in the lower level conference room at the Village Hall and was called to order at 6:01 p.m.

PRESENT: (and constituting a quorum): Chairman Lies and Commissioner Hoffenberg.

ABSENT: Commissioner Kerpan.

ALSO PRESENT: Andrianna Peterson, Assistant Village Manager; Renee Strasser, Police Chief; and Don Gay, Fire Chief.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Approval of the minutes of the June 6, 2016 meeting was deferred until the next meeting of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners.

3. BUSINESS AT HAND

A. Appointment – Police Department – Candice Nevins-Cassiberry

Chief Strasser reported that based upon the findings of the background investigation and results of other required pre-employment tests, she recommended the appointment of Candice Nevins-Cassiberry to the position of probationary Police Officer.

Chief Strasser further reported that if the BOFPC concurs with the recommendation, Ms. Cassiberry would attend the POWER test on June 28, 2016 and Police Academy beginning July 11, 2016.

After discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Hoffenberg and seconded by Chairman Lies to appoint Candice Nevins-Cassiberry to the position of Probationary Police Officer. Motion carried.

B. Appointment – Police Department – Michael Kaiser

Chief Strasser reported that based upon the findings of the background investigation and results of other required pre-employment tests, she recommended the appointment of Michael Kaiser to the position of probationary Police Officer.

Chief Strasser further reported that if the BOFPC concurs with the recommendation, Mr. Kaiser would attend the POWER test on June 28, 2016 and Police Academy beginning July 11, 2016.

After discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Hoffenberg and seconded by Chairman Lies to appoint Michael Kaiser to the position of Probationary Police Officer. Motion carried.

4. OLD BUSINESS

Chief Strasser reported that seventy candidates applied to participate in the testing process for the next Police Officer Eligibility List. The test will take place on Saturday, June 25, 2016 at Lyons Township High School.

5. NEW BUSINESS

Chief Strasser reported on the status of personnel matters and recent police incidents.
