1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

A meeting of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners (BOFPC) of the Village of La Grange was held on August 15, 2018 in the lower level conference room of the Village Hall and was called to order at 6:01 p.m.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES- JULY 18, 2018

The minutes of the July 18, 2018 meeting were presented for approval. After consideration, it was moved by Commissioner Boersma and seconded by Commissioner Kerpan that the minutes be approved. Motion carried.

3. BUSINESS AT HAND

A. Approval – Police Officer Final Eligibility Register (corrected)

Chief Bluder reported that after the July 18 BOFPC meeting, our vendor, IO Solutions, notified us that one of the candidates, Egwin Loya, reported that his military preference points had not been added to his final score. IO Solutions determined that an oversight had occurred and provided a corrected version which impacts those applicants ranked 28 through 34. As a result of the error, the BOFPC is asked to approve the revised and corrected version of the Police Officer Final Eligibility Register.

After consideration, it was moved by Commissioner Boersma and seconded by Commissioner Kerpan that the Final Police Officer Eligibility Register be approved. Motion carried.

5. NEW BUSINESS

Chief Bluder reported that the Police Department has launched a back to school campaign focusing on pedestrian safety. A new safety initiative called “Be the Change, Travel Safe in La Grange” has several components meant to raise awareness of both pedestrians and motorists.

Commissioner Kerpan noted that he sometimes sees squad cars parked on Ogden Avenue when pulling over a vehicle. For safety reasons he suggests that they pull over to a side street.
