Re: Monthly Report for June 2019

Attached for your review are the significant events and general statistics for the shift activities during the month of June 2019. This was a very busy month for the police department due to the different events that took place to kick off the start of summer.



On June 1st, the Village of La Grange staffed the 73rd Annual Pet Parade. This necessitates a large number of officers in order to ensure the safety of all parade goers and participants. All staff members, who are not on vacation, are required to work the morning of the parade. We also solicited assistance from neighboring jurisdictions and many provided help. This event was a great success.

On June 1st, several members of the police department again volunteered to staff a dunk tank at the LGBA Carnival. These volunteers agreed to be “dunked” with all the money raised being donated to the Hinsdale Humane Society. The volunteers were able to raise \$400 for the Humane Society. The Hinsdale Humane Society was chosen in keeping with the Pet Parade theme and because they house all stray pets for the La Grange Police Department that cannot be immediately reunited with their family.



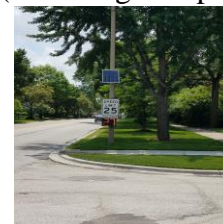
On Monday, June 14th and Monday, June 24th, the La Grange Police Department conducted a Truck Enforcement Detail, with an enforcement emphasis on La Grange Road. The officers working the detail made 21 traffic stops, issued 15 compliance citations, 2 traffic citations and 29 warnings. Many of the warnings were for equipment related issues where something is very close to needing to be replaced (tires) but not at the point a citation was warranted.

In an effort to continue to address traffic safety, the La Grange Police Department deployed two of its solar powered electronic speed display signs in the 200 block of La Grange Road and its battery powered electronic speed display signs in the 900 block of 7th Avenue. The signs are used to increase awareness, act as a deterrent and to collect data.

On Tuesday, June 4th, La Grange School Resource Officer Tim Andries and Western Springs School Resource Officer Ashlee Niezgodka provided Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate or ALICE training to all staff from Lyons Township High School. In

August of 2018, the LT administration began reviewing different options for aggressive intruder situations beyond the standard locking down procedure. The administration decided that they wanted to implement ALICE and worked with the School Resource Officers to establish training for this program. This change in procedure took months to develop and culminated with staff training. The training included staff participating in various scenarios within their classrooms.
