Re: Monthly Report for November 2020

November was another busy month for the Police Department. It began similar to the last several months but, due to the surge in COVID-19 cases, Governor Pritzker implemented Tier 3 Mitigation standards on November 20th. This caused some training to be cancelled/rescheduled and for the Police Department to reevaluate its procedures. Below is a summary of the Police Department's activity for the month of November.



On Monday evening, November 9th, Officer Casey Gomorzak was sworn-in at the Village Board meeting. Officer Gomorzak completed his academy classwork on Friday, November 6, 2020, and took the State certification exam on Monday, November 9, 2020. Officer Gomorzak received the “Academic Achievement



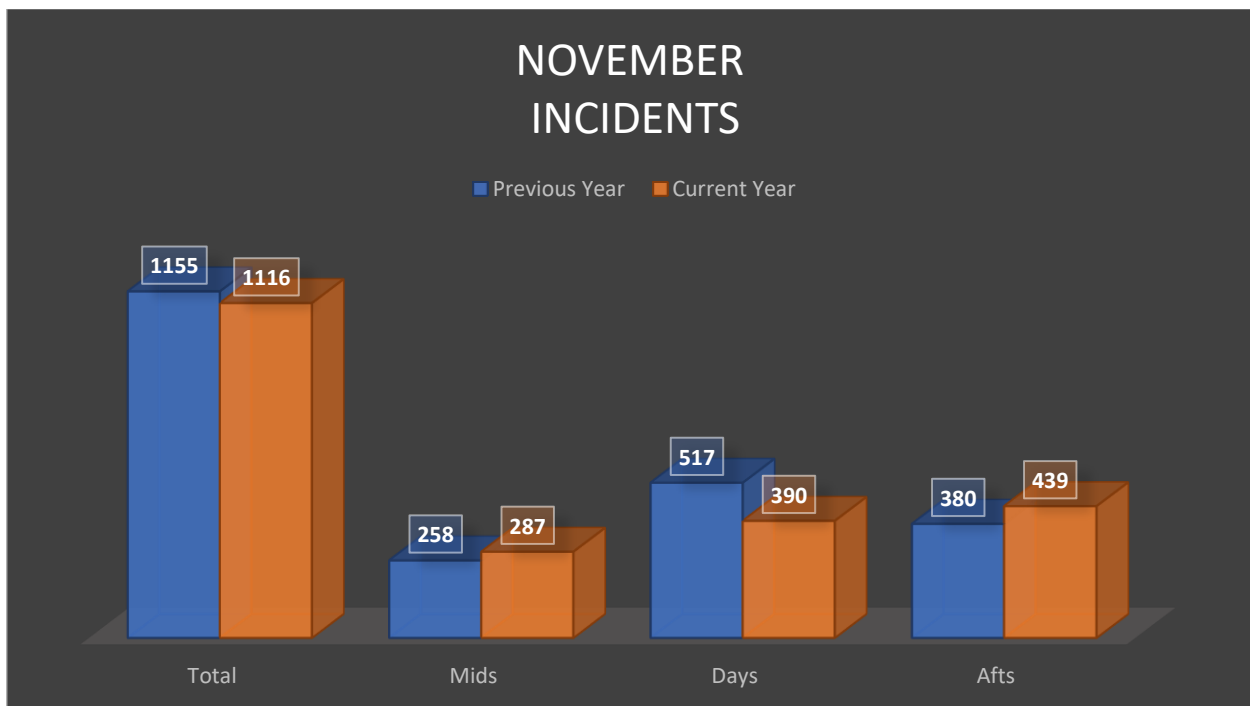
Award” from the Suburban Law Enforcement Academy for having the highest academic average within his academy class on all the exams. This is quite an achievement. He was #1 out of 47.

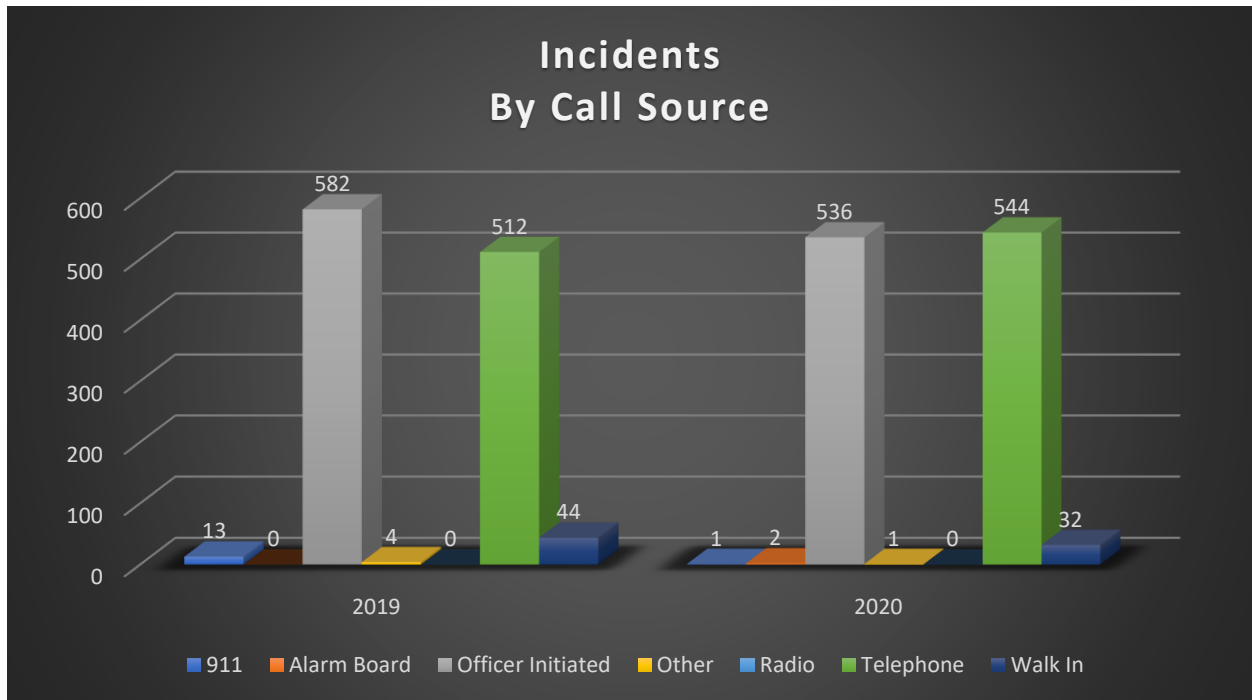
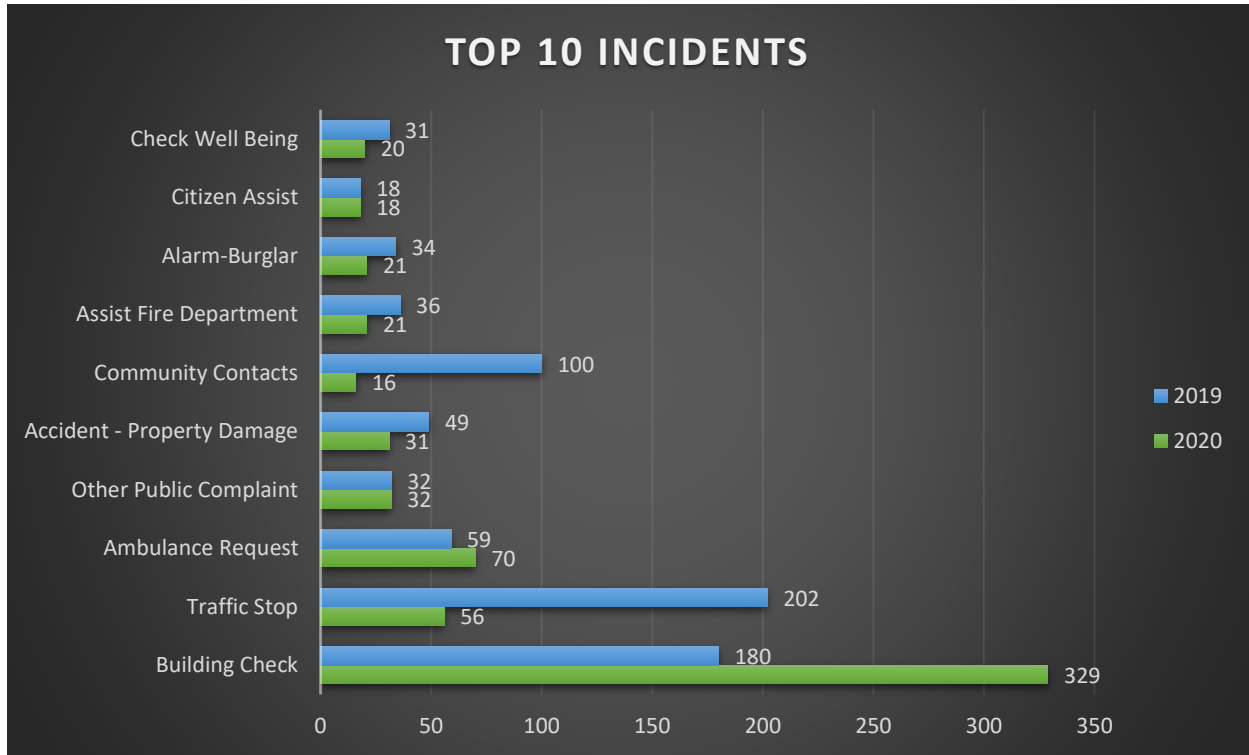
On Monday, November 9th, the La Grange Village Board approved the purchase of Getac Tablets, Getac In-car Camera systems, and various equipment for the new squad cars that should be delivered in January. This was a several month process, which required meeting with vendors, scheduling demonstrations, researching the products, and obtaining multiple quotes. 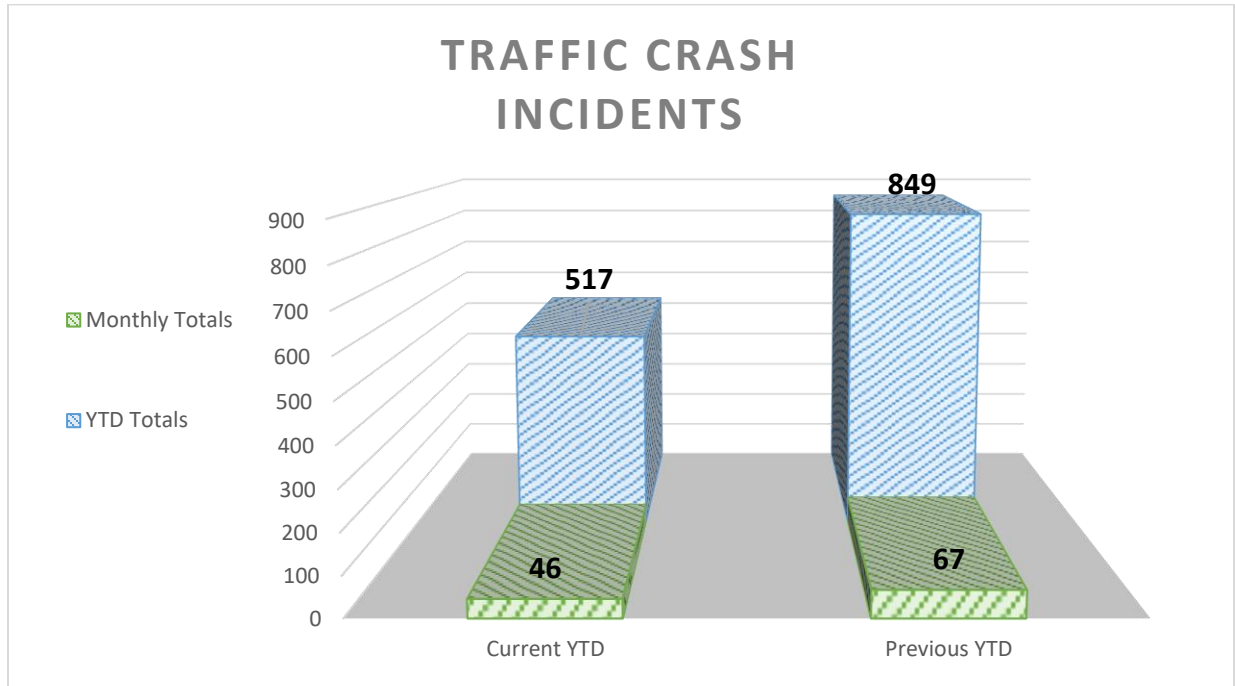
On Tuesday, November 10th, Probationary Police Officer Casey Gomorzak began Phase 1 of Field Training with Field Training Officer Ryan Nemecek. After completing 560 hours of academy training, Officer Gomorzak will undergo an additional four (4) months of “field” training.

On Wednesday, November 8th, the La Grange Board of Fire and Police Commissioners approved the Final Eligibility Register for the position of Police Officer. A written exam was proctored on Saturday, October 10th and after applying preference points for education, military service, and prior law enforcement experience, the final list was established.

Officer Tom West has been working in our evidence room and on background investigations for potential new Officers since the Suburban Law Enforcement Academy suspended in-person learning on October 28th. This was done due to the statewide surge in COVID-19 cases. A tentative return date of January 4, 2021, has been scheduled for Officer Tom West.







November Training

On Monday, November 9th, Officer Candice Cassiberry, and Sergeant Adam Coleman attended a one-hour training class titled, “Why Mental Health First Aid?” This class was held virtually and provides attendees with the skills needed to give initial support to someone who may be developing mental health or substance abuse problems and help in connecting them to the appropriate care. The course was sponsored by the Intergovernmental Risk Management Agency or IRMA.

On Monday, November 9th, Sergeant Ken Uher attended a class titled, “Incident Command for Improved Patrol.” The class focused on real-life events and processes, with students being challenged to make their responses safer and more effective. Topics covered included departmental policy considerations, current case law, court-accepted practices, criminal and/or civil consequences, incident resolution strategies, related tactical readiness, and ethical decision-making concerns. The class was sponsored by NEMRT and was held at the Wheeling Police Department.

On Friday, November 13th, Deputy Chief Dave Rohlicek and I attended “Law Enforcement Media and Social Media Strategies for a Changing World.” The course teaches proven social media strategies to connect directly with the public and manage negativity. The course covered topics such as creating engaging content, avoiding common social media pitfalls, managing online negativity, crisis communication, and understanding the visual impact of media. The class was hosted by the Skokie Police Department.

On Tuesday, November 17th, Officer Kyle Niewold attended a one-day Standard Field Sobriety Test Refresher course. This one-day refresher course assists participants in becoming more

proficient in recognizing and interpreting evidence of DUI violations, administering and interpreting Standard Field Sobriety Tests, and describing DUI evidence clearly in both written reports and verbal testimony. The class was hosted by NEMRT and was held at the Bensenville Police Department.

On Tuesday, November 17th, Deputy Chief Dave Rohlicek participated in a virtual class titled, “The Dynamics, Science & Liabilities of Force Events.” This course covered topics such as Policy vs. Proficiency, tracking of training, post-event decisions, and use of force reviews.

On Wednesday, November 18th, Officer Steve Rogers attended a one-day Enforcing Cannabis Laws 2021 class. The class is designed to provide officers with a comprehensive overview of the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act, including a review of the DUI provisions related to adult-use cannabis and utilizing non-standard Field Sobriety Tests. The class was held at the Franklin Park Police Department.

On Wednesday, November 18th, and Thursday, November 19th, Officer Taylor Falls attended the 16 Hour Sexual Assault Investigator course. The class is designed to meet the needs of law enforcement personnel tasked with conducting sex crime investigations and includes topics such as trauma and the neurobiology of the brain, what it means to be victim-centered and trauma-informed, and how to conduct trauma-informed interviews with victims and social media and evidence gathering from the internet was discussed. It also provides a background in how trauma impacts the manner in which survivors are able to report, enforcement and the criminal justice system, how to focus on offender behaviors as well as hold offenders accountable and conducting trauma-informed, survivor sensitive interviews. The class was sponsored by NEMRT and was held at the Countryside Police Department.

DAYSHIFT ACTIVITIES

ARRESTS:

Dara V. Fitzpatrick (37 YOA), of Western Springs, IL was charged with reckless driving, leaving the scene of an accident, operating a vehicle while on a cellphone, and driving on a sidewalk after striking multiple barricades and driving at utility workers who were performing work in the roadway.

Two La Grange juveniles were charged with criminal damage to property after being identified in several cases of vandalism and damage to property.

OTHER POLICE ACTIVITY:

The Dayshift shift completed 19 traffic contacts during November of 2020. Shift Officers completed 29 Illinois Traffic Crash reports. The shift also issued 63 parking/compliance citations

for equipment and other parking violations and conducted 35 Building/Business Premise Checks as well as Foot Patrols.

TRAINING:

Ofc Rogers attended training for Enforcement of Cannabis Laws in 2021.
Ofc Gomorzczak began his first phase of Field Training with Ofc. Nemecek.
Lexipol DTB's and Illinois Police Law completed by the shift.

AFTERNOON SHIFT ACTIVITIES

INVESTIGATIONS:

Ofc. Irizarry conducted an investigation into a Domestic Battery. The victim/complainant in the matter refused to identify themselves as well as provide suspect/offender information during the interview. The case was closed due to a lack of cooperation.

Afternoon Shift members conducted several Investigations into Identity Thefts involving the Illinois Department of Employment Security. No suspects have been identified at this time. The cases were closed due to lack of information.

ARREST / CITATIONS:

Ofc. Falls and Ofc. Rogers, assisted by Ofc. McDermott and Inv. Kang arrested two 14-year-old La Grange, IL juveniles for Criminal Damage to Property. The juveniles were placed on Formal Station Adjustments.

Ofc. McDermott, Ofc. Irizarry, Ofc. Kaiser, and Sgt. Coleman, initially investigated a Domestic Battery complaint. A forensic interview of a juvenile victim was deemed necessary, at which point the case was turned over to the Investigations Unit and DCFS. Inv. Fulla assisted by Inv. Kang conducted follow up and the forensic interview was completed. The offender was later located and arrested. The 38-year-old offender from La Grange, IL was charged with one count of Felony Domestic Battery-Strangulation and later transported to court for a bond hearing. Case closed.

OTHER POLICE ACTIVITY:

Afternoon Shift Officers responded to 439 calls for service, which included 156 building checks, 63 special watches, 32 initial case reports, 10 supplement reports, and 1 arrest report.

TRAINING:

Sgt. Coleman attended IRMA Risk Management training related to Why Mental Health First Aid.
Ofc. Comstock attended training related to Saving Blue Lives (Mental Health/PTSD).
S/L McDermott attended training related to Physical Surveillance for Law Enforcement.
Ofc. Falls Attended two days of training related to Sexual Assault Investigations.

PTO. Egan completed online mandate training related to Review of Use of Force and Sexual Assault Trauma-Informed response.

All shift members completed the annual Illinois State mandate training on Sexual Harassment Prevention.

MIDNIGHT SHIFT ACTIVITIES

ARRESTS:

Ofc. Wolf arrested a 37-year-old male subject, from Lisle, for Driving under the Influence (D.U.I.) and other traffic offenses. The subject was processed and released on bond with a return court date.

Ofc. Cassiberry arrested a 29-year-old female subject, from Racine, WI. for Driving under the Influence (D.U.I.) and other traffic offenses. The subject was processed and released on bond with a return court date.

OTHER POLICE ACTIVITY:

The Midnight shift completed 11 traffic contacts and investigated 1 property damage traffic accident. Shift Officers issued 45 parking citations for overnight parking and other violations. The Officers also conducted 190 Building/Business/Special Watch Premise Checks and Foot Patrols. In addition, one member of the shift, who is assigned to the NIPAS Mobile Field Force (M.F.F.), responded to call-outs to assist the Evanston P.D. with citizen protests/demonstrations, which occurred in their community, and call-outs for possible civil unrest/demonstrations during the General Election.

TRAINING:

The shift continued completing the monthly Police Law Institute online training lessons, along with the monthly Lexipol Daily Training Bulletins. In addition, Ofc. Wolf completed the Low Light Engagement and Tactics training course. Ofc. Cassiberry completed the "Why Mental Health First Aid?" training course through IRMA. Ofc. Niewold completed the Standard Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) Refresher training course.

INVESTIGATIONS DIVISION ACTIVITIES

INVESTIGATIONS:

Nothing critical to Report.

ARREST / CITATIONS:

Inv. Kang assisted Ofc. Falls and Ofc. Rodgers with the arrest and interviews of two 14-year-old juveniles from La Grange, IL for the crime of Criminal Damage to Property. Both juveniles were placed on Formal Station Adjustments.

Inv. Fulla assisted by Inv. Kang conducted a follow up on a Domestic Battery incident that originally occurred during the Afternoon Shift. The offender was located and arrested. The 38-year-old offender from La Grange, IL was charged with one count of Felony Domestic Battery-Strangulation and later transported to court for a bond hearing. Case closed.

OTHER POLICE ACTIVITY:

Inv. Kang assisted La Grange Park PD as a member of the Major Case Assistance Team with a Home Invasion.

Inv. Kang attended a four-day John Reid Interview & Associates training on Interviews and Advanced Interrogation.

Inv. Kang assisted the Spring Grove PD and the Department of Homeland Security with Korean translation in reference to an ongoing investigation.

Inv. Fulla and Inv. Kang assisted Justice PD as a member of the South Suburban Major Crimes Task Force with a Homicide Investigation.

Inv. Kang completed several backgrounds for Village Liquor License Applicants.

Inv. Fulla and Inv. Kang completed Illinois State-mandated annual training on Sexual Harassment Prevention.

Inv. Fulla completed online Illinois State Police Crime Laboratory training related to the recording of sexual assault kits (CheckPoint).

AUXILIARY AND PART-TIME POLICE UNITS

The Auxiliary Unit was inactive during the month of November due to the COVID-19 pandemic so the Police Department does not have anything to report related to their activities.

The part-time officers responded to 68 calls for service in the community. The part-time officers' activity is lower than usual because they were assigned to the parking deck and downtown area for patrol duties.

PARKING DIVISION

The parking division registered \$14,675 in parking fines through conventional payments, online payments, or collection efforts.
