## CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

### Sewer Lining/Rehabilitation Project



November 16, 2018

Dear Residents:

The Village is pleased to announce that the 2018 Sewer Lining/Rehabilitation Project is planned to start in November, 2018 and is scheduled to be completed by March, 2019. You are receiving this notification as the sewer on your street that serves your property was identified as needing repairs. The Village will be repairing the sewer by utilizing a process called cured-in-place pipe lining. This method of sewer rehabilitation will provide a new pipe within the existing pipe and does not require traditional open trench excavation methods. In some areas, spot sewer repairs that require excavation will be required prior to lining. The contract for this project was awarded to Insituform Technologies USA, LLC.

Instead of digging up and replacing the old pipeline, the cured-in-place lining process provides for the insertion of a special lining inside the pipe, creating a new smooth-surfaced, long-lasting pipe within the old sewer. Normally each section of sewer to be reconstructed will require up to a 12 hour period to install the liner and cure it in place. During this time the sewer connection to your home or commercial establishment will be sealed off. Consequently, you will be asked to make limited use of your toilet facilities and refrain from doing laundry for 12 hours.

Sometime during the next several months you will receive a white door hanger informing you of the time and date of your 12 hour limited water use period. (If work is canceled for that date you will receive a red door hanger notifying you of the cancellation).

Also, prior to the work, we recommend that you verify all of the sewer vapor traps within your home are filled with water. Specifically, we recommend that you take a minute to pour several cups of water into each basement floor drain. It keeps the trap full, which prevents sewer odor from coming into your home. Because the water evaporates, this should be done regularly.

Please note the planned sewer repairs are weather dependent and if it is raining or snowing the work will be scheduled for a subsequent day since the sewer is also used to drain storm water from the streets. We anticipate on the day of lining that some traffic will be re-routed around the work zone depending on the manhole location. Access to your property will not be affected. As soon as the new sewer is cured-in-place, sewer service will be restored.

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Thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation. We will work with the contractor to minimize the inconveniences associated with this project. If you have any other questions, please do not hesitate to contact me at (708) 579-2328.
