## CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Project: Brewster Avenue Water Main Improvement Project

Issue Date: April 4, 2019

Contractor: Superior Excavating

Work Area: Brewster Avenue from La Grange Road to Spring Avenue



The purpose of this notice is to provide an update on the Brewster Avenue Water Main Improvement Project. The schedule of work for the next several weeks is as follows:

**Completed – Monday, March 18, 2019 to Friday, March 29, 2019**

- Started the installation of the 8” water main from La Grange Road to Spring Avenue

**Planned - Monday, April 1, 2019 to Friday, April 5, 2019**

- Excavate small pits in parkway to locate five private water service lines to confirm material type and size.
- Continue installation of 8” water main

**Planned – Monday, April 8, 2019 to Friday, April 12, 2019**

- Install new fire hydrants and valves at each intersection
- Connect new water main at Kensington Avenue
- Pressure test the new water main.
- Chlorinate and test new water main

Once the contractor has completed all of the exploratory excavations to determine the material and size of the private water service lines, we will send each property owner a letter communicating this information. This information may be helpful to some in making the decision to replace their water service line and are unsure of the water line material. We expect you will receive this letter in the next one to two weeks.

Please provide the Village with the response to the Water Service Line Work Selection Form as soon as possible. We understand that some are waiting for the above information and will submit the response after the additional information is received.

The construction manager for the project will also be following up individually with those residents that have not yet responded.

As a reminder, on-street parking on Brewster Avenue from La Grange Road to Spring Avenue will be restricted during the project; however residents can park on adjacent side streets if needed. Signs will be posted in the area notifying motorists of these restrictions. The Police Department is aware of this accommodation and will not be ticketing vehicles that park on the street if their driveway is inaccessible. All vehicles parked on-street will need to be parked in a legal space, which includes not blocking fire hydrants, intersections or driveways.

Please note that all schedules are weather dependent.
