Project: FY2019-20 Ashland Avenue and Blackstone Avenue
Water Main Replacement Project

Work Area: Ashland Avenue from Harris Avenue to 47th Street
Blackstone Avenue from Cossitt Avenue to 47th Street



The purpose of this notice is to provide an update on the Ashland Avenue and Blackstone Avenue Water Main Replacement Project. The schedule of work for the next several weeks is as follows:

Completed – Monday, April 15, 2019 to Friday April 19, 2019

- Completed exploratory excavations to determine material type and size of private water service lines on Blackstone and Ashland Avenues
- Completed installation of water main, valves and fire hydrants on Blackstone Avenue
- Completed pressure test and chlorination testing for portions of the new water main on Blackstone Avenue
- Began transfer of private water service lines from the old water main to the new water main on the 400 block of Blackstone Avenue

Planned - Monday, April 22, 2019 to Friday, April 26, 2019

- Continue transfer of private water service lines from the old water main to the new water main on the 400 block of Blackstone Avenue
- Begin tree root pruning and installation of tree fences on Blackstone and Ashland Avenues
- Begin installation of 8" water main on Ashland Avenue
- Begin spot sewer repairs on Ashland Avenue

Over 

Planned – Monday, April 29, 2019 to Friday, May 3, 2019

- Continue installation of water main on Ashland Avenue
- Continue to transfer water services on Blackstone Avenue

As a reminder, on-street parking on Ashland Avenue from Harris Avenue to 47th Street and on Blackstone Avenue from Cossitt Avenue to 47th Street will be restricted during the project; however residents can park on adjacent side streets if needed. Signs will be posted in the area notifying motorists of these restrictions. The Police Department is aware of this accommodation and will not be ticketing vehicles that park on the street if their driveway is inaccessible. All vehicles parked on-street will need to be parked in a legal space, which includes not blocking fire hydrants, intersections or driveways.

Please note that all schedules are weather dependent.
