CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Project: Brewster Avenue Resurfacing Project

Issue Date: June 6, 2019

Work Area: Brewster Avenue from La Grange Road to Spring Avenue



Now that the water main project is complete, the roadway resurfacing work will begin. The roadway resurfacing project is a joint partnership between the Villages of La Grange and La Grange Park since Brewster Avenue serves as the boundary between the communities. The roadway project will consist of intermittent curb and sidewalk repair, asphalt resurfacing, and pavement striping. The work is scheduled to begin the week of June 10 and be completed by the end of July.

The construction sequence for the project will generally be as follows:

- Repair sewers and other underground infrastructure.
- Replace deteriorated curb and gutter, and sidewalk.
- Remove existing asphalt surfaces, and adjust drainage structures.
- Install new asphalt roadway pavement.
- Repair any damaged parkways.

During the project, the goal is to provide continuous access to your property while the work is completed. However, there will be certain work activities that may temporarily limit access to your property such as curb and sidewalk repairs. Signs and notices will be provided describing the work activity and expected restrictions closer to when the activity is expected to occur. Residents will be notified if driveway access will not be allowed and where parking will be available during that time.

On-street parking on Brewster Avenue will be restricted during the project; however residents can park on adjacent side streets if needed. For example if access to your driveway is blocked, overnight parking will be allowed on adjacent side streets. The Police Department is aware of this accommodation and will not be ticketing vehicles that park in legal parking spaces on adjacent streets next to the project area.

Generally the contractor will be working between the hours of 7 am to 5 pm, Monday through Friday.

We plan to provide periodic updates on construction operations, activities and progress through notifications similar to this one. Also, construction notices of impending construction activities that may affect traffic, parking, utilities, or other issues will be provided in advance of those operations.

Thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation. We will work with the contractor to minimize the inconveniences associated with this project. The end result will be an improved street that will provide many years of service.
