CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Project: Ashland Avenue Roadway Reconstruction Project

Issue Date: August 7, 2019

Work Area: Ashland Avenue from Cossitt Avenue to 47th Street



The water main project has been completed, thank you for your patience. Starting next week, the roadway contractor will begin the removal and replacement of the concrete curb, sidewalk and driveway aprons. The concrete work will be divided into two phases: Phase 1 – West side of Ashland Avenue, Phase 2 – East side of Ashland Avenue.

In order to complete the work, access to your driveway will be restricted for up to ten days. **All vehicles on the side of the street where work is occurring will need to park on an adjacent side street during the day from 7 am to 5 pm, Monday through Friday.** Outside of this time period (5 pm to 7 am), you can park on the opposite side of Ashland Avenue from where the work is occurring, however your vehicles need to be moved to an adjacent side street by 7 am each morning.

The following is the anticipated schedule for the next several weeks:

Phase 1 – West Side of Ashland Avenue (Vehicles on this side need to be moved out of driveways by Monday, August 12)

Anticipated Schedule: Monday, August 12 to Wednesday, August 21

Order of Work: Concrete removal (curbs, sidewalks, driveways) – 2-3 days
Concrete forming – 1 day
Pour concrete curb – 1 day
Pour concrete aprons and sidewalks – 2 days
Restore driveway access – 1 day

Phase 2 – East Side of Ashland Avenue

Anticipated Schedule: Thursday, August 22 to Friday, August 30

Order of Work: Same as above

Please note that the concrete requires at least three days of cure time prior to driving on the new surface with vehicles. If you are expecting heavy delivery trucks, we recommend giving the concrete more time to cure.

The Police Department is aware of the parking accommodation and will not be ticketing vehicles for overnight parking in this area. All vehicles parked on-street will need to be parked in a legal space, which includes not blocking fire hydrants, intersections or driveways.

Sidewalk removal and replacement will only include replacing sidewalks at intersections and where trip hazard exists.

Please note the above schedules are weather dependent and may need to be adjusted based on unforeseen circumstances. The overall schedule is to complete the concrete work in August, and asphalt paving and landscaping in September.
