## CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Project: Blackstone Roadway Reconstruction Project

Issue Date: September 27, 2019

Work Area: Blackstone Avenue from Cossitt Avenue to 47<sup>th</sup> Street



The contractor has finished with the sprinkler repairs and grading of the parkway. The following is the remaining schedule for the project:

Friday, September 27 – Placement of sod

Saturday, September 28 – Placement of sod

Thursday, October 3 – Final layer of asphalt placed

For the first several weeks, the contractor is required to water the newly placed sod in order to establish the new grass. Once this establishment period is complete, we recommend that you also water the sod, depending on weather, to achieve the best outcome.

As noted above the final layer of asphalt is planned for next week. Prior to placement of each asphalt layer, a bituminous prime coat (which looks like oil) will be sprayed on the roadway. This material helps bond the existing sub-base to the new asphalt. This material can be driven on; however it can transfer from the road to car tires. If you pull back into your driveway after driving over this material, it will cause black tire marks on the new concrete driveways. These marks are difficult to remove. **Therefore, do not drive over the bituminous prime coat and then back onto your driveway until the new asphalt surface has been placed.** We anticipate this driving restriction will only last for a few hours.

Lastly, punch list items such as repairs to some brick walkways and driveways will be completed in the coming weeks as well.
